

# Allan to remain acting VVC Superintendent/President

VICTORVILLE • Peter Allan was approved by the Victor Valley College Board of Trustees on Tuesday to continue as acting Superintendent/President of the college.

Allan received a 4-0-1 vote to remain the college's acting superintendent/president until an interim is appointed.

Allan — who will submit an application to be considered as an interim replacement for Dr. Christopher O'Hearn — said he is ready, willing and able to do anything the college needs him to.

"I'll be working on accreditation," Allan said after the meeting. "We have a follow up report that is due in October, we've got that pretty well drafted."

After enough candidates resumes are collected, the board of trustees will hold a special meeting to narrow down the choice of whom they would like to interview to be the school's interim superintendent/president.

A special board of trustees retreat was held on May 31 and was recorded, just like all the other meetings. Public concern arose after the retreat's video was not posted on the college's website.

Board President Lorrie Denson said the video was to be used as a resource for the future trustee who will join the board after June 30 to have an understanding of the role of a trustee.

"It was never intended to be on the website," Denson said at the meeting. "I have no problem with anyone seeing it. ... If it's an overwhelming consensus for you all to see it, I have no problem with that. ... I was the one who said that. If you want to get upset at someone, it was me."

Board Vice-president Michael Krause did not attend the meeting, marking the fourth consecutive board gathering he has missed. Krause submitted a letter of resignation in May, effective June 30.
