Brady Appointed to VVC Board of Trustees

SVL brokerage firm president wins seat out of 11 finalists

VICTORVILLE • Joseph W. Brady, president of The Bradco Companies brokerage firm in Victorville, won the appointment to serve as trustee for Victor Valley College late Tuesday night.

The Victor Valley Community College District Board of Trustees chose Brady out of 11 finalists on a 3-1 vote around 9:15 p.m. at the end of a nearly five-hour public meeting.

The four sitting trustees grilled each finalist during the open session on various issues, including what they would look for in the next president, how they would handle various ethical dilemmas, whether they would run for the seat in 2012 and how they might help solve the college's financial woes.

The board then privately ranked the candidates based on the interviews before proceeding with nomination motions. It took 13 nomination motions before the board secured a majority vote.

Brady won the board's support on the third motion to select him, with Trustee Michael Krause opposing.

The trustee position became vacant when former Trustee Angela Valles resigned in November so she could assume her post as a member on the Victorville City Council.

Brady will serve the remainder of Valles' term, which expires in 2012.
