Occupation: Incumbent board member; real estate brokerage owner 1. 'We need to be cultivating our youth and working with our high schools a whole lot better than we do,' Brady said. 'I'd like to see a more collaborative effort with industry out here. I would like to see 100 percent of our students graduate, stay here and become a part of the thriving economy again.'

2. Brady said VVC's main campus still has 'a lot of space to develop.' He mentioned that when the college bought the land located on Highway 395, it was while he and fellow incumbent John Pinkerton were not on the board, but that the college 'really got the shaft when we bought that property.'

As far as creating satellite campuses, Brady suggested looking into 'other alternatives,' particularly utilizing existing structures rather than building new ones.

3. Brady said it wasn't until the college 'changed its attitude on this campus' that the issue of accreditation was addressed. 'It's a problem we have to own,' Brady said, noting the importance of involving all of the college's constituency groups.
